A sporty watch inspired by motorised sports, this watch is fitted with an automatic ETA 7750 movement. Its steel 48 mm case has a transparent back and a prominent crown protector.

The balance pulses at 28,800 vibrations per hour. The strap integrated into the bezel assures perfect comfort for the wearer thanks to a patented suspension. The watch is delivered with three straps: steel, rubber and leather. It is waterproof to 100 metres. www.formexwatch.ch

An automatic ETA 2678 movement slotted into a steel case measuring 33 mm in diameter. The mother-of-pearl and diamond dial displays hours, minutes, date and day. The transparent base reveals the decorated movement. Water-resistant to 100 metres. Crocodile-style leather strap with folding buckle.

Noemia**

The polished stainless steel case measuring 32 mm in diameter, is set with 64 full-cut diamonds, and is fitted with a natural white mother-of-pearl dial decorated with four Roman numerals and eight full-cut diamonds on setting for a total of 0.4 carats. The strap in white leather with pin buckle. Quartz movement.

Epoca**

The polished steel case is set with 26 full-cut diamonds; the dial is available in eight different versions. The matching strap with folding buckle. Swiss-made quartz movement. Water-resistant to 30 metres.

Volta**

A mirror-polished steel case of a diameter of 42 mm presenting a second time zone. The button for correcting the time is on the back, so there is no crown. The white silvered opalin dial is set with 92 diamonds (0.28 carats) with the second time zone on mother-of-pearl dial. Alligator strap with interchangeable spring bar and extra strap in black technological satin. Quartz ETA movement.
